<p><u>Maths</u> This half term we have been focussing on our times tables. Write out the times table that you have been working on in class and see if you can spot any patterns. Are the patterns the same with a different table?</p>	<p><u>DT</u> This half term we have read lots of different books. Can you create a model of one of the characters from your favourite book?</p>	<p><u>Science:</u> Autumn is a time when the leaves start changing on trees. Draw a tree in each season (Spring, Summer, Autumn, Winter) and explain what happens to the leaves in each season. Challenge: Explain WHY the leaves change in each season.</p>
<p><u>Geography: London and Beyond</u> Create a map of London City. Include a key to show what different building might be. You may also like to include a list of directions and/or compass directions.</p>	<p><u>English: Once upon a book!</u> This half term's topic has been 'Once Upon a Book'. Select your favourite book that you have read in class or at home and write a book review. Include the main characters, setting, problem and solution.</p>	<p><u>History</u> On November 5th the UK celebrate Guy Fawkes Night. Research who Guy Fawkes is and write a fact file on him. Challenge: Make a list of any more important historical dates that happened in November</p>
<p><u>Rights Respecting</u> Climate change is affecting the whole world, particularly those in poorer countries. What can we do to help those that are being affected by the severe weather changes? Write your ideas down as a poster.</p>	<p><u>Art:</u> On the 5th November fireworks are seen in the sky to remember Guy Fawkes. Create your own picture, collage, painting or photo collage of a fireworks display.</p>	<p><u>Visit: London and Beyond</u> Visit central London and see what London landmarks you can spot. Take some photos and write a recount about your day out!</p>
