


Cut off one end of the paper. Use scissors to cut the middle. 2. Draw the lantern shape on the paper, inside or outside. 3. Fold over your paper to form the lantern shape. 4. Cut the lantern shape along the middle. Use scissors to cut the paper. 5. Unfold the paper. 6. Hold the lantern together on the bottom and use glue to hold it in place. 7. Trace the lantern on the top of the paper. 8. Trace the lantern on the bottom of the paper. <p>Why not try painting the lantern with coloured paper?</p> 	Find a fantastic story to listen to here. Make a Paper Lantern


You will need

Lantern Template (Below)
Red paper (optional)
Red and gold paint / coloured pens
Scissors
Glue
Sticky tape
Stapler


Instructions

1. Print the lantern template onto plain or red paper as desired
2. Cut off the end of the paper and set aside to create the handle
3. Decorate the sheet using coloured pens or paints (red and gold are traditional Chinese new year colours)
4. Fold the paper in half lengthwise along the dashed line
5. Cut along the marked lines on the sheet and cut to the edge of the paper.
6. Unfold the paper.
7. Curve the paper round to form a cylinder shape.
8. Tape the two ends of the paper together to create your lantern
9. Staple the handle to the top of the lantern.








Handle
