<p><u>Maths:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Learn your times tables and look for links, example between 4 and 8 x table. Build up your mental maths ability to add and subtract numbers in your head. Learn your number bonds with 3 digit number, eg. what do you add to 273 to make 300? 	<p><u>DT/Art:</u></p> <p>Create a model of the digestive system using resources from home e.g scarf as the intestines, small bag as the stomach, bottle cap as the rectum etc. Label it and take a photo or draw it in your homework book!</p>	<p><u>Science:</u></p> <p>Experiment eating a range of different textured foods eg:</p> <p>Hard: pears, apples, carrots, cucumbers, bell peppers</p> <p>Soft: bananas, cereal, tangerine, sandwich (bread)</p> <p>Chewy: haribos, cheese, chewy sweets etc</p> <p>Write down what teeth are working the hardest when you eat these foods.</p>
<p><u>Geography:</u></p> <p>Make a map of your local area. Try to include a key to show roads, shops, post office, religious buildings and bus stops.</p>	<p><u>English:</u></p> <p>Imagine you are opening a new farm that doesn't kill animals like Mr Zuckerman's farm. Write an advertisement for a new farm that is animal friendly and does not use animals for their meat. If you want, you can create a poster.</p>	<p><u>R.E:</u></p> <p>This term we have been looking at war and suffering. Write down a way you can help those that are in suffering or in need of help, e.g a family who have no access to water, a child who cannot go to school</p>
<p><u>Rights Respecting (Article 12: Respect the rights of the child)</u></p> <p>Think about what you would like to be in the future e.g doctor, lawyer, teacher. Write the skills you will need to achieve these in thought bubbles around the edge and draw a picture of you as your future self!</p>	<p><u>Art:</u></p> <p>Next half term's topic is 'Take One Picture'. Take or draw a picture of your favourite moment at school this half term and explain what is happening in that moment. E.g receiving an achievement award, doing the digestive experiment, seeing your photo in the Tate Modern Gallery.</p>	<p><u>History:</u> 'How do countries defend themselves against invasion?'</p> <p>Think about when the Anglo-Saxons invaded Britain and pushed them out of their country. If this happened in 2020, what measurements do you think Britain would take to defend themselves? Be sensible in your response.</p>
